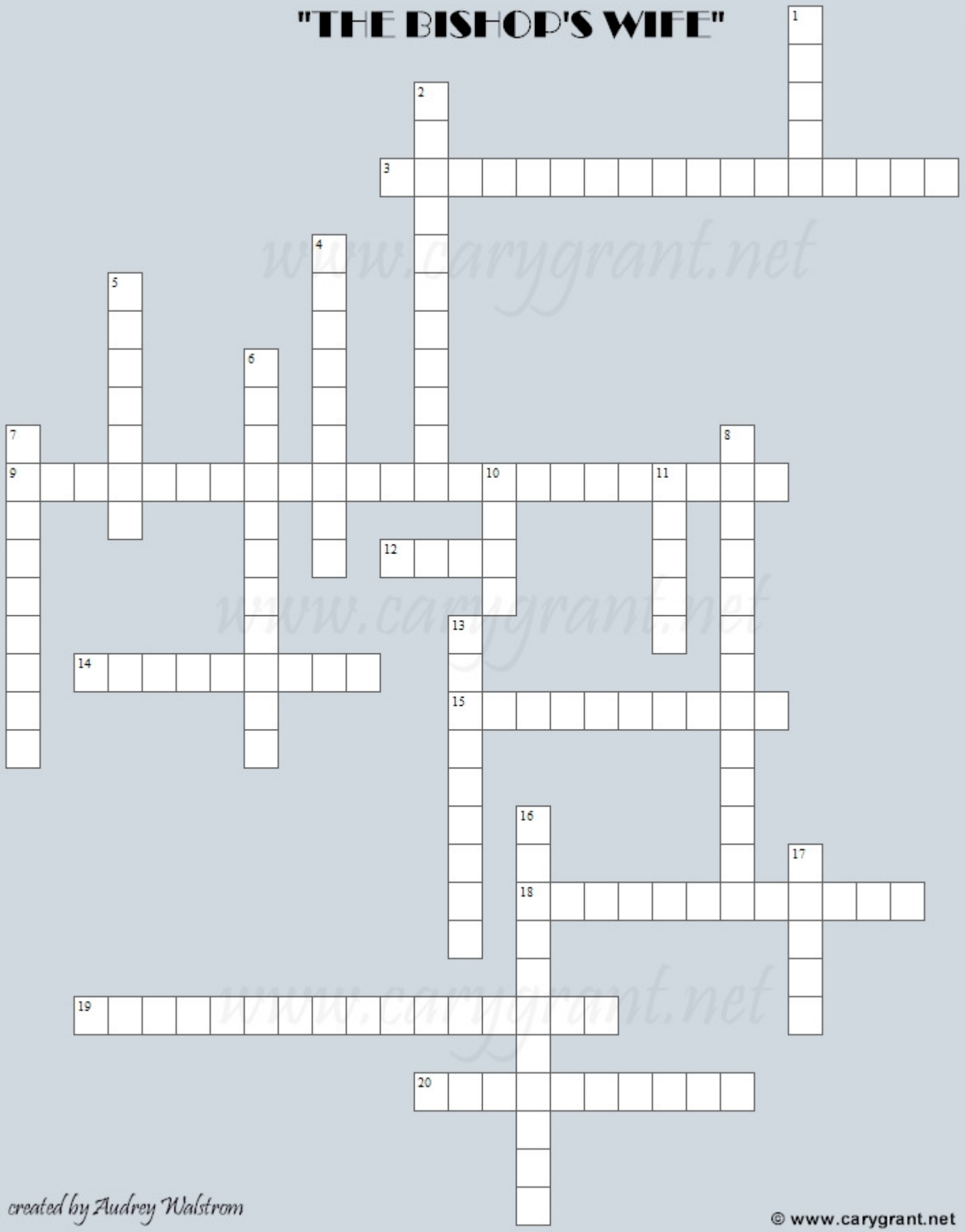


# "THE BISHOP'S WIFE"
